The Organisation

ARD (Association for Refugees with Disability) a refugee led organization for persons with disabilities whose mission is to raise awareness of refugees with disabilities within humanitarian context operates in 6 refugee settlements in Uganda including Nakivale. ARD is in partnership with Humanity & Inclusion to implement two projects in Nakivale Refugee settlement i.e INSPIRE which focuses on SRH (Sexual Reproductive Health) and HVP (Humanitarian Assistance for the very vulnerable Refugees) focusing on comprehensive rehabilitation and mental health with main focus on new arrivals. These projects are for 1 year from September 2024- August 2025.

ARD is seeking to recruit volunteers preferably youth both girls and boys, persons with disabilities across all age working groups, both form the refugee and host community.

Job summary

Under the supervision of the Project Assistant, the Community Based Facilitators will carry out;

- Translation support according to the language and or dialect used in the field to the project staffs in the community within the project work schedule.
- Act as a focal point of contact for ARD & HI in the community and facilitate a harmonious relationship between the
 organizations and the community.
- · Provide up-to-date information and activity schedule of the project activities to the community and partners
- Keep the ARD & HI informed about the needs and issues in the community they belong to or assigned.
- Assist in Aassessments i.e., Disability, barriers and facilitator, satisfaction surveys.
- Participate in mobilization for awareness raising sessions
- Identification of persons with disabilities, Injuries and those with MHPSS & SRH needs including elderly, the youth and children.
- Responsible for day-to-day management of the project's working spaces with in the health centres.
- Any other responsibilities as assigned by the line manager.

- Ability to speak Fluent English and translate in at least two different local dialects spoken in Nakivale Refugee settlement but Kiswahili or Somali is MUST.
